BOOKING OFFICE



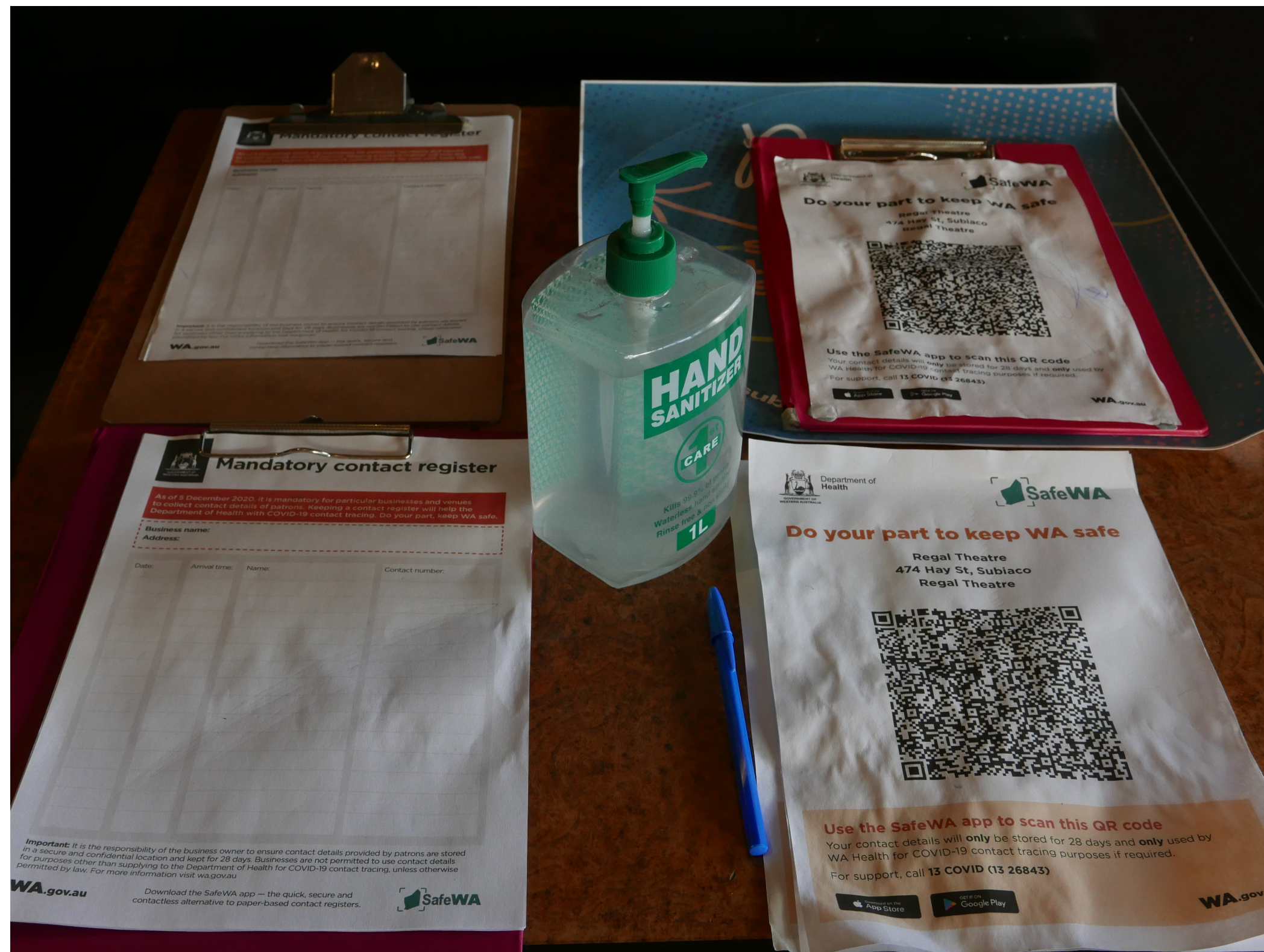
If I need to collect my tickets, I will collect them at the booking office.

ENTERING THE THEATRE



I will show the usher my ticket before I can enter the theatre.

SEATS



When I enter the

LIGHTS



When the show starts, the lights will darken a little.

DOORS



The doors will remain open during the performance. If I need to leave, go to the toilet or the quiet area, I can do so.

QUIET AREA

I can go to the quiet area during the performance if I need to relax. It is on the first level. There are bean bags and art materials at the quiet area.
